

Proposal for Mortar and Artillery Training (PMART) at Richardson Training Area Schedule

The U.S. Air Force (USAF) issued a Notice of Intent (NOI) to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to assess the potential social, economic, and environmental impacts associated with the Proposed Mortar and Artillery Training (PMART) at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson (JBER). The USAF is the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) lead agency, and U.S. Army Alaska (USARAK) is the proponent and cooperating agency, for this EIS process. The Draft EIS is expected in late 2020.
